Academic Activities:

<u>Literacy</u>: We will introduce the book <u>The World of Ants</u> by Melvin Berger. The children will explore this nonfiction text and talk about the table of contents, the index, and how the book is similar, or different, from other books we have read. We will begin our "All About Books" for our animal research project.

<u>Sight Words</u>: This week we will learn the high frequency words no and and. <u>Math</u>: As we approach the 100th day of school we will practice counting beyond double-digits. Students will review forming two dimensional shapes on the geoboard. Using pattern cards, we will practice completing patterns with up to four

<u>Science</u>: We will continue answering our animal questions and learning all that we can about our animals.

<u>Social Studies</u>: This week we will learn more about one of France's most famous painters, Claude Monet. We will admire his paintings, and learn about Paris' most famous museum: Le Louvre.
